Or perhaps you are concerned about the green space that this expansion will encompass, if so, we encourage you to attend this open house to see the measures they are taking to minimize their impact or footprint and do the least damage to our parks and loss of park space.

You also may be curious as to why this expansion is even necessary or how long it is going to take.
